D1 | Arrive Beijing **Jade Palace Hotel or equivalent**

Today, you'll arrive in Beijing, the capital city of China. Your tour guide will greet you at the airport arrival hall and then transfer you to your deluxe hotel for a good night's rest.

D2 | Beijing (B, L, D) **Jade Palace Hotel or equivalent**

Beijing served as the capital of 5 dynasties over a period of 800 years. Start your city tour with a visit to the **Tiananmen Square**, the largest public square in the world. Next stop is the **Forbidden City**. This complex, the largest and most intact conglomeration of ancient structures of the imperial palace ever built in the world, features more than 800 buildings with 9999 rooms, resplendent golden-glazed roofs, red lacquered pillars and walls. In the afternoon, continue your tour to the **Temple of Heaven**, which was used by Emperors to offer sacrifices to heaven and pray for good harvest in ancient times. In the evening, enjoy a fabulous **Peking Roast Duck Banquet**. Return to the hotel for rest or attend an optional energetic show - "Legend of Kung Fu" at your own expense.

D3 | Beijing (B, L, D) **Jade Palace Hotel or equivalent**

The highlight today is a trip to the astonishing **Great Wall** at Juyongguan Pass. More than 12,000 Kilometers in total, the Great Wall is the most famous image of China throughout the world. It is the only manmade object visible from the moon, and as one of the Eight Wonders of the world. It is also a symbol of Chinese traditional culture and the pride of the Chinese nationality. On the way to the Great Wall this morning, you'll also have an opportunity to shop at the largest **Jade Centre of Asia**. After lunch, see skilled artisans at work at a **Cloisonné Factory**. Then, take motor coach to the **Sacrificed Way of Ming Tombs**. Back to city, walk along the **New Qianmen Street** and have an outside view of the beautiful **Bird's Nests and Water Cube** up close. After dinner, cap off the day by attending a superb performance of **Chinese Acrobatic Show**.

D4 | Beijing (B, L, D) **Jade Palace Hotel or equivalent**

The morning, visit the exquisite **Summer Palace (Imperial Garden)**. It is the largest ancient preserved garden in China and a former summer resort for Emperor. A shopping visit to the **Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences** will be arranged shortly after lunch. In the afternoon, visit the **Lama Temple**. It houses a treasury of Buddhist art including sculptured images of gods, demons and Buddhas, as well as Tibetan-style murals. Later on, you will have the chance to experience **Hutong life** by exploring the ancient Beijing Alley District by a rickshaw, plus a visit to a local family and local market.

After breakfast at hotel, you will be transferred to airport for departure flight.
